

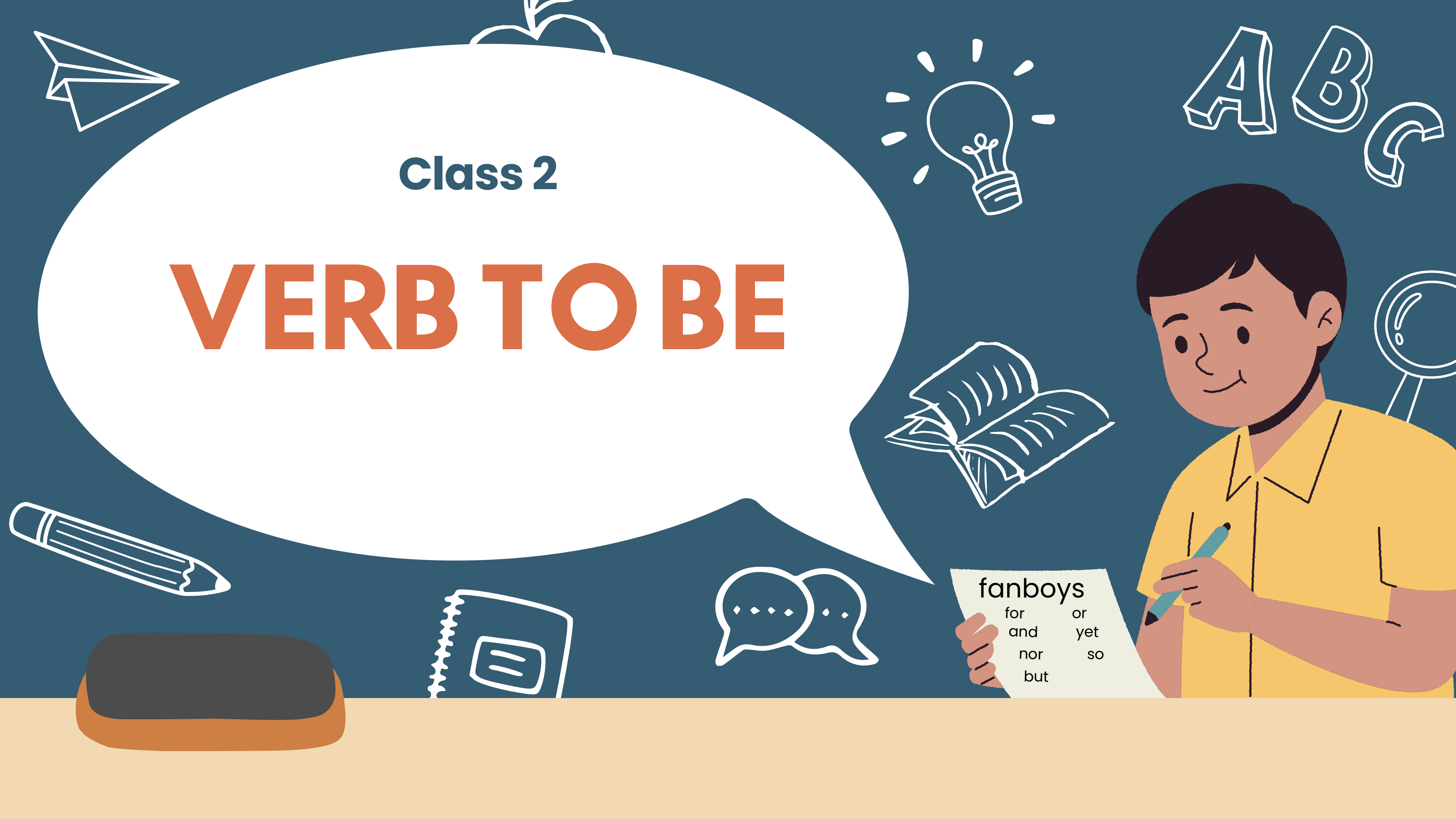

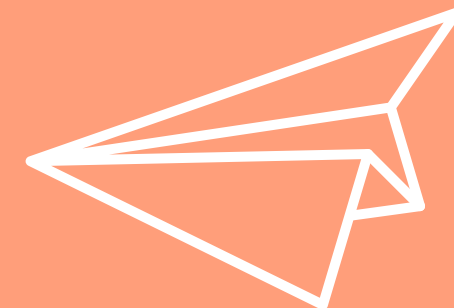

Indicate nationality or origin: "We are Mexican."



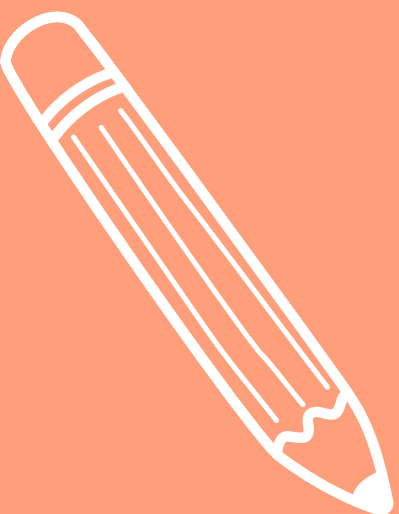
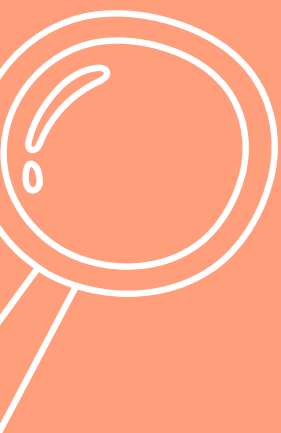
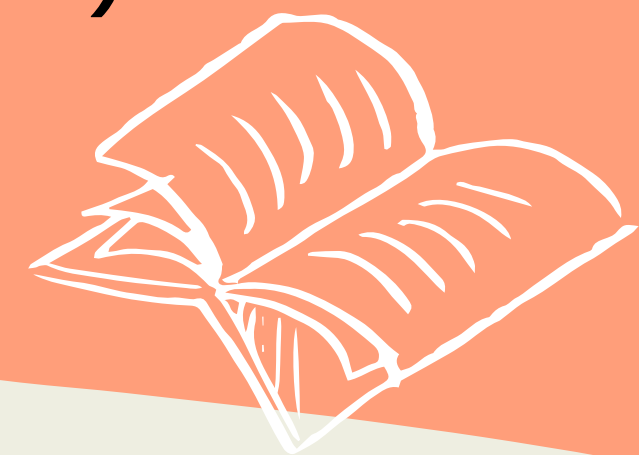
State age: "He is 30 years old." (Even though in Spanish we use "tener," in English it's with "to be.")



Describe moods or conditions: "I am tired."

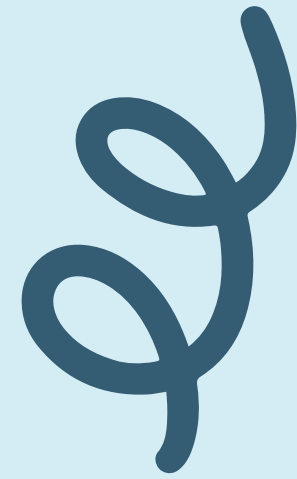


Express locations: "They are here."
